

Is an emotional or behavioral problem keeping your preschool-aged child out of preschool or child care?

K-Prep is an intensive treatment program with an educational component. This program helps children and families identify and begin to explore “needed skills” and introduce strategies that support children to change unsuccessful behavior patterns and attitudes before returning to a regular preschool setting.

Specific criteria reviewed by the placement review team:

- Must reside within the service boundaries of USD 305, Salina Kansas.
- Must be determined at risk with behavioral challenges that have made it difficult to be successful in a typical preschool or childcare setting.
- May have a current Individual Education Plan (I.E.P.) or 504 Plan or agree to a special education or 504 evaluation.
- Parent or guardian must actively participate and support the child in treatment planning and medically necessary services such as case management, individual, and family therapy, and other services deemed necessary by the family and treatment team.
